An island approximately 4 km long between the "old bridges" on the North Saskatchewan River. The island is home to a variety of animals. It is laced with trails that are trimmed in the summer for the nature lovers and they are groomed in the winter for cross-country skiing and skate skiing. **Sorry, but snow mobiles, all terrain or vehicular traffic is not allowed.**



### Battleford Trails

The Trans Canada Trail is the most ambitious endeavour ever embarked upon by the volunteer sector in Canada. When complete, an 18,000-kilometre recreational corridor will wind its way through every province and territory, linking over 800 communities along its route! This will be the longest trail of its kind in the world, connecting our regions, our three oceans and our people in a new way for generations to come. Our local section of the Trans Canada trail now runs from Fort Battleford to the new bridge across the North Saskatchewan River. It can be enjoyed by walkers, joggers and cyclists year-round.

This versatile and multi-use, air conditioned facility can accommodate weddings, conferences, meetings, banquets, cultural events, volleyball, basketball, badminton, etc. The main hall has a tiled floor with 3 meeting rooms, a bar, coat check room, full service kitchen, 2 separate change rooms for sports activities and a portable stage. The hall can accommodate 500 for a dine/dance, 675 for a banquet, 800 for a meeting. A full-time caretaker prepares the facility for each function, and is available to open the hall for previewing.
