The Town of Battleford has a new Public Safety Officer.

AI starts March 1, 2018 and he works out of the Parks and Recreation Office as well as the Town Hall.

The Public Safety Officer is responsible for enforcing municipal by-laws and providing public education and awareness programs and services in order to ensure the protection of residents, property and employees. Through the course of his duties, the Public Safety Officer will be required to respond to complaints, investigate appropriately, issue tickets as required, participate in judicial hearings and court proceedings, and follow law enforcement policies and procedures. Other responsibilities will include administrative tasks such as the creation and maintenance of records, preparation of associated reports, and the management of the By-Law enforcement budget.

The Bylaw Officer, under the direction of the CAO, will primarily be responsible to:

- To educate the public about Bylaw issues
- To inform the public about current Bylaws
- To work with the citizens of our Community
- To Provide a Safe and Healthy Community
- We are committed to professional bylaw enforcement that is responsive to our citizens.

The expected outcome of the position results in a town that is beautiful, clean, safe for all with healthy neighbourhoods. To achieve this the Bylaw Officer will engage the community to review and update existing bylaws, develop new bylaws as needed, and enforce existing bylaws.
