Town of Battleford - Cemetery Marker Regulations



TOWN OF BATTLEFORD Cemetery Marker Regulations (Updated April 2023)

1) MARKERS:

ONLY BRONZE AND GRANITE MARKERS ARE ALLOWED IN THE CEMETERY. No markers will be permitted that are manufactured of concrete, artificial stone, composite, wood, tin, or iron.

Only <u>FLAT markers</u> are allowed in the **New Section** (Catholic, Protestant, Cremains, and Vet-Legion). Markers must be mounted on a concrete base with the base flushed below the ground and the marker flushed at ground level. (except the Vet-Legion Section, see below). Vases must be retractable to ensure the ease of ground-keeping maintenance.

All markers are to be installed at the head of the grave, on solid ground. If more than one marker is installed on the same grave plot, the second marker will be installed directly below the first marker. No foot markers allowed.

- 2) The cost of cemetery permits for marker installation or other cemetery work is \$15.00 (no gst).

 Permit forms are available from Town Hall. Approval and payment must be obtained from Town Hall before the installation of the marker or other cemetery work commences.
- Marker installations and other cemetery work are only permitted during <u>regular hours</u> Monday to Friday between 8:00 am to 12 noon and 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm from April 15th to October 1st each year.
 No marker installations or other cemetery work will be allowed on a Saturday, Sunday, or Statutory Holiday(s).

The Funeral Home, Memorial Company, or Family Member must contact the Parks & Recreation Department at (306) 937-6216 <u>during</u> the above working hours to make the necessary arrangements for the marker installation and/or cemetery work.

The Funeral Home, Memorial Company, or Family Member must present their copy of the approved cemetery permit to the Parks & Recreation Employee who will then <u>supervise</u> to ensure the marker is stalled properly or cemetery work done according to the Town regulations.

- 4) The following items are <u>NOT ALLOWED</u> in the Cemetery:
 Fences, borders, railing, curbs, coping, trellises, walls, hedges, decorative rock or bark, trees planted,
 flowers planted or grave coverings, slabs, gravel, artificial carpet, glass, pottery, metal containers, metal
 rods, statues, solar lights, ornaments, or wooden crosses.
- 5) All flowers are to be removed by the first Monday in October each year and vases are turned down to avoid damage in winter. The Town reserves the right to remove and dispose of any flower arrangement(s) or non-permitted item(s).
- 6) Animals are **NOT ALLOWED** in the cemetery.
- 7) All vehicle traffic <u>must</u> remain on the roadways.

MARKER SIZES / GUIDELINES:

(Adult Size Plots) New Section (concrete base and markers):

(i) Granite markers must be installed within a concrete base.

(ii) Bronze markers with a height of no more than 1" may be installed on top of the concrete base.

(iii) The concrete base must extend a minimum of 3" beyond the edge of the marker on all sides and must be a minimum depth of 3" thick. The concrete base is to be installed level with the surrounding ground.

Single-size grave

Marker - Maximum

30" long and 22" wide

Concrete Base – Maximum

36" long and 28" wide

Double-size grave

Marker - Maximum

50" long and 22" wide

Concrete Base – Maximum

56" long and 28" wide

*Note: Marker sizes are dictated by grave size not occupancy. Single-size grave (1 plot), Double size grave (2 plots side by side).

Cremains and Infant Sections (concrete base and marker):

(i) Granite markers must be installed within a concrete base.

(ii) Bronze markers with a depth of no more than 1" may be installed on top of the concrete base.

(iii) The concrete base must extend a minimum of 3" beyond the edge of the marker on all sides and must be a minimum of 3" thick. The concrete base is to be installed level with the surrounding ground.

Single-size grave

Marker - Maximum

20" long and 18" wide

Concrete Base – Maximum

24" long and 24" wide

Double-size grave

Marker - Maximum

42" long and 18" wide

Concrete Base – Maximum

48" long and 24" wide

(Adult Size Plots): Vet-Legion Section marker guidelines:

A Concrete runner is provided for the installation of markers. Note: The runner is only 12" wide.

Single-size grave

Marker – Maximum

24" long x 12" wide

Double-size grave

Marker – Maximum

48" long x 12" wide

Only **flat** bronze or granite markers are permitted. Bronze markers shall be <u>installed directly</u> on the concrete runner provided. Granite markers <u>shall be cut into and leveled with</u> the concrete runner. Both markers shall be <u>without</u> a provision for a vase.

If there are two markers for one grave plot, the first marker is to be installed directly on the concrete runner. The second marker is to be installed in the ground; located directly below the concrete runner (head of the grave). If the second marker is bronze, it must be on a concrete base. If the second marker is granite, then no concrete base is required.

^{*}Note: Marker sizes are dictated by grave size not occupancy.

Single-size grave (1 plot), Double size grave (2 plots side by side).

Town of Battleford - Cemetery Marker Regulations

(Adult Size Plots): Old Section (concrete base and marker):

(i) The concrete base must extend a minimum of 3" beyond the edge of the marker or sub-base of the marker and must be a minimum of 3" thick. The concrete base must be installed level with the surrounding ground.

Double-size grave

Marker - Maximum

50" long and 22" wide

Concrete base - Maximum





Upright markers may be allowed in the Old Section only if they complement the surrounding markers in the same area. All installations are subject to Council approval regarding the style, function, and manner of the existing installations.

Battleford Cemetery Columbarium



The Town of Battleford initiated the development of a Columbaria Garden at the Town Cemetery in the spring of 2013.

The beautiful granite Columbaria offers 48 niches measuring 12x12x14" that will accommodate up to two urns of cremated remains depending on size of urns (please ensure to check with Funeral Home first).

A 12x12" black granite door cover is included with the purchase of a niche on which you can memorialize the deceased. (Please see inscription specifications).

All niches are double sealed and bolted with tamper proof hardware assuring the utmost in security.

This interment garden will become a show piece over time as more columbaria are installed and landscaping is maintained.



The Cemetery Bylaw requires that a permit be obtained and approved prior to a monument being installed for any and all work of markers **prior to the commencement of such work**. The Town will only install memorial wall and columbarium plaques, not cemetery grave markers. Funeral Home, Memorial Company or family are responsible to install the grave marker(s) as per Town Regulations and must contact Parks & Recreation Dept. at (306) 937-6216 (Monday to Friday 8:00 am to 12:00 noon & 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm) **before installation** of the marker(s). Cheques are made payable to Town of Battleford.


